Campsite and Glamping Rules

We hope your stay at the Dalriada Festival Campsite will be a very enjoyable one, so ask for your compliance with the rules for your own safety and the safety and comfort of other guests around you:

Arrival & Departure

- Arrival from 12noon on Friday 12th July. Departure no later than 12noon on Monday 15th July. Reception/check-in closes at 9pm on Friday 12th July.
- All visitors must report to reception on arrival. As noted on our website, your campsite
 pitch includes for up to 6 people there will be a £10 charge per extra adult or youth
 (12-16years).
- Cars are only permitted in the campsite on arrival to set up they then must be moved to the designated car park once offloaded.
- All motorhome and caravan owners with an electric pitch must bring their own 30m electric cable with 16amp socket. Tents with electric require a 13amp extension lead (Min. 10m in length).

Noise & Games

- No loud music or rowdy behaviour is permitted at any time.
- This is a family festival therefore we ask that you respect other guests on the campsite and keep noise to an absolute minimum between 11pm 8.00am.
- Ball Games are not permitted near vans and pitches (please use the designated area).
- · Generators are not permitted.

Dogs & Pets

- Dogs must be kept on short leads when not inside a caravan or tent.
- Please clean up after your pet (dog waste bins can be seen on the campsite map).

Fires & Barbecues

- Open fires are strictly prohibited anywhere on site.
- Barbecues are permitted but must be supervised at all times. All disposal barbecues
 must be disposed of in the 'Barbecue Disposal Bin' marked on the map. PLEASE DO NOT
 USE WASTE BINS AS THIS COULD CAUSE A FIRE.

Accidents & Insurances

- Caravans, motorhomes and vehicles entering the campsite do so at the owner's risk. No
 responsibility is accepted for loss, damage or injury on the site, however caused. We
 strongly advise guests check that they have appropriate insurances for the period of
 their stay.
- All accidents or incidents on the site must be reported and recorded at the security hut.

First Aid

24 hour Emergency First Aid cover will be available throughout the weekend.
 (Should you have an <u>emergency</u> first aid situation, please contact on-site security or event staff immediately).

Please be mindful that Glenarm Castle Estate is a working farm. We would ask that you adhere to all signs for your own safety.

The proprietors reserve the right to refuse admission or ask any guest failing to comply with these rules to leave the site immediately without refund.
